



## IN MEMORIAM: P/C Jere D. Dando, AP



Past Commander Jere D. Dando, AP, passed away on April 6, 2021 at age 85. An avid sailor, Jere joined Northern Virginia Power Squadron in 1981 and achieved senior status in 1993. He became Commander in 1996. With typical Dando enthusiasm, Jere, with his wife Nancy, led the squadron through a busy year of boating education, picnics, rendezvous and cruises. At the D5 spring conference, Jere was featured snoozing in an inflatable raft in the "NO WAKE ZONE." Years later Jere described the entire experience as, "Fast! Great! Challenging, Rewarding, Exhilarating, Satisfying. What a ride!"

Jere supported many commanders who succeeded him and in 1998 he and Nancy donated a trophy to be awarded annually to a Past Commander for continuing service to the squadron. He earned 15 well deserved merit marks.
